- **General Practice Nursing and HCA Conference 2022**

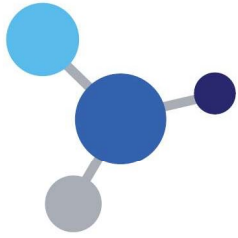

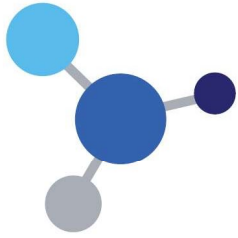
