Funding:

Education funded by Apprenticeship Levy. *Or 5% employer contribution for educational element if Levy not available. Please note that this levy transfer is only available to non-levy paying organisations.

ARRS funding also available to salary PCN recruited Nursing Associate Apprentices.

Commitment:

- 2 years part-time level 5 study, practice placements and insight visits
- Able to commit to a 37. hours working week plus personal study time
- Able to travel county-wide to placements and University of Lincoln Campuses
- Fixed holiday periods for 2 years

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants must either already be employed by a primary care organisation or recruited into a new Nursing Associate Apprenticeship post via PCN open recruitment—See NHS jobs for adverts

Education Qualifications Requirements:

Minimum of GCSE Grade 4-9 (Grade C or above) or Functional Skills level 2 in English and Mathematics

These qualifications must be evidenced with initial application

Benefits:

- Increased workforce retention, providing comprehensive nursing career progression for existing clinicians or people new to healthcare.
- Offers the opportunity for PCNs and practices "grow their own," shaping individuals to fit into developing nursing teams, to address specific practice needs.
