# CPD Funding:

Information for Practices and PCNs

# Background Information

We are pleased to announce that the CPD funding programme has been extended to the 2023/2024 financial year. As in previous years, all nurses, nursing associates and AHPs are eligible to access £333 of funding for CPD training. CPD monies can be used to fund courses taking place at any time during the financial year but cannot be carried over to the next financial year.

Please note that, in line with NHSE guidance, CPD funding cannot be used for travel and accommodation expenses, backfill or mandatory training.

## Process for 2023/2024

Each eligible practitioner must apply for CPD monies by completing the Google Docs form at the link below and either booking a CPD package on the local menu of courses organised and booked by Lincolnshire Training Hub, or alternatively indicating that they wish to undertake a course of their own choice.

**CPD local menu courses:** The monies for these courses will be held by LTH and paid to the course provider directly.

**Cancellations:** As these courses will be booked at scale to deliver optimum value for practitioners, please note that places booked via the above Google Docs form cannot be cancelled. If a clinician is unable to attend, they will not be able to reclaim CPD monies to spend on alternative training.

If courses are oversubscribed, additional dates will be booked. If any course does not have the minimum number of people signed up 56 days prior to the course start date, the course may be cancelled. If this happens, we will contact those who have booked onto the course in question to offer alternative training.

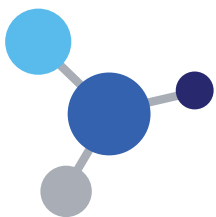
