# Enablers

Current supervision / assessor requirements	<b>SSSA</b> replaces previous training. Training may only take 2 hours - more information on training is available through the Lincolnshire Training Hub <a href="#">Supervision and assessor training</a> Practice Assessor and Practice Supervisor must be 2 different people <a href="#">NMC webinar SSSA HCPC statement on supervision</a>
Physical space - room capacity	Could you share capacity with your PCN using a hub and spoke model. Students don't have to be in the surgery for all of their hours consider insight visits, remote work which may include directed study or developing evidence to support a face to face session.
Staff time & cost implications	All students have an allocated tariff - please contact <a href="mailto:Stacey.Mayol@nhs.net">Stacey.Mayol@nhs.net</a>  Hub staff can provide support
What do the students need? What can they do?	All students will have a Placement Assessment Document with learning outcomes, we have mapped some of these to Primary Care work and may be able to provide examples
Staff aren't really interested in hosting students	This is part of your professional registration. NHS workforce policy recognises the need to increase recruitment and retention targets. We need to invest in the workforce to address future capacity, expansion in Primary Care is crucial. Expanding placements means we can provide more opportunities for healthcare professionals
I will need to create an induction pack and timetable.	Students on placement have portfolio documents which often include mandated induction criteria, in addition the Lincolnshire Training Hub has resources to help with this
We haven't had students before, I don't know how to arrange this, will it take a long time and a lot of work to sort out?	Staff at the Lincolnshire Training Hub and University will be able to help with the process, SSSA training and placement audit can both be completed usually within a matter of weeks.
What students can we host?	Wide range of Nurses and AHPS including; paramedics, OTs, Physios. Supervision can be undertaken by any healthcare professional but practice assessor must be on the same part of the register as the student they are assessing.
What benefits will we gain?	There is a tariff allocated for hosting students, this will vary but could be around £127 a week for paramedic placements and £135 for nurse and AHP placements.
