Working with older adults team to assess frail patients in community and avoid hospital admission.

Working alongside care coordinators to improve outcomes in patients living in care homes.

Proactive assessment and management of patient's needs in their early 60s to early identification of frailty signs.

Working alongside the cancer care coordinator to ensure proactive management of cancer patients to improve outcomes.

Work alongside the social prescribers to empower adults with mental health problems to improve their everyday lives.

Works alongside MSK clinics/GP clinics to support patients with health and work problems to self-manage.

Weeks	Actions	Date Completed
Week 1	Induction to General Practice /PCN Setting aims and objectives with OT Supervisor. Observe different teams: admin, reception, etc. Shadow Nursing team/ACP/SP/Pharmacist/Physio. Shadow GP clinics as well as on call clinics. Identify potential areas for the project. MDT meeting attendance.	
Week 2	Shadow Nursing team/ACP/SP/Physio Shadow GP clinic as well as on call clinics. Continue with identified tasks e.g., admin, reception work and skills development. MDT meetings attendance. Weekly supervision OT.	
Week 3 & 4	Continue with of project development and work on caseload. Continue with tasks and shadowing opportunities as required. Complete case-based discussions as required. Weekly supervision OT.	
Week 5	Finalise project. Practice delivering audit project presentation. Weekly supervision OT.	
Week 6	Complete final tasks and skills development, reflection, and evaluation activities. Deliver final audit project presentation and evaluate feedback. Weekly supervision OT.	

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
